

Understanding Social Care Networks

Social Care Networks are connecting Medicaid Members who qualify to temporary services like **housing supports, food and nutrition assistance, transportation, and navigation to social care services.** These services contribute to Members' overall health and well-being.

Across New York State, there are regional Social Care Networks made up of healthrelated social needs service providers, health care providers (including behavioral health), and other partners focused on:



Accessing services through Social Care Networks

Members may be eligible if they:

- 1. Are enrolled in Medicaid Managed Care
- 2. Demonstrate unmet health-related social needs (HRSNs)
- 3. Belong to an Enhanced Service Population

Medicaid Members who have identified needs but do not meet specific eligibility criteria may be navigated to HRSN services delivered by pre-existing state, federal, and local programs
